**NACCS CONCLUDES SERVICE PROVIDER AGREEMENT WITH  
'CrimsonLogic Pte Ltd.' REGARDING ADVANCE FILING RULES**

**Kawasaki, Japan- 25 April 2013-** Nippon Automated Cargo and Port Consolidated System, Inc. (NACCS Center) concluded service provider agreement with 'CrimsonLogic Pte Ltd.' (Singapore) to enable Carriers and NVOCCs in foreign countries, the filers of the newly enacted Japan's Advance Filing Rules, to report electronically through NACCS to Japan Customs.
