


1. Precise information on 6th generation NACCS (2)

No.	Item	Outline	Remark	
3	System Maintenance	In 6 th generation NACCS, which works 24h/365d, system maintenance will be conducted every two month in the 3 rd Sunday. (January, March, May, July, September and November). During system maintenance, 6th generation NACCS will stop operation from 2:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. (JST)* ³ . * ³ In response to change in the law and urgent program change etc., we might change system maintenance time. (In such case, we will inform you through our AFR website.)	 Frequency on system maintenance will decrease compared with <i>current NACCS</i> operation. No specific effect for Service Providers. 	
4	Required time for system switching	In 6 th generation NACCS, required time for system switching* ⁴ between main center and back-up center will be greatly shortened as follows; <current naccs=""> (1) Switching from main center to back-up center; about 1 hour after determining switching. (2) Switching from back-up center to main center; about 8 hours (= 4 hours a day × 2 days). <6th generation NACCS> (1) Switching from main center to back-up center; about 30 minutes after determining switching. (2) Switching from back-up center to main center; about 30 minutes after determining switching. (2) Switching from back-up center to main center; about 1 hour *4 System switching will be done in the case of catastrophe or large scale system errors.</current>	 In 6th generation NACCS, even if there should be system switching, NACCS will automatically change connection destination for SP. Therefore, <u>SP do not have to pay attention to</u> the destination for sending data. 	



4-2. Prior Notification from Japan Customs (in Phase II)

If filers wish to receive Prior Notification as a test, please implement AFR procedures in the following manner during <u>Customs response duration in Phase II</u>; from **Monday, July 31, 2017** to **Thursday, August 3, 2017**.

Cancellation of "DNL, DNU or HLD"	- Enter "CXL *" at the beginning of Goods Description in CMR or CHR .	 Available only for those filers who already have received DNL, DNU or HLD. Japan Customs will accept requests until Thursday, August 3, 3:00 p.m. (JST).

<Note>

① Japan Customs might not be able to send Prior Notification within 24 hours after AMR/CMR or AHR/CHR. Further, there is a possibility that Japan Customs can not send Prior Notification.

- ② Japan Customs will arbitrary choose manifest information for sending Prior Notification.
- ③ Prior Notification in Running Test includes no specific directions from Japan Customs.
