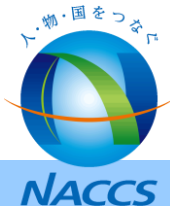
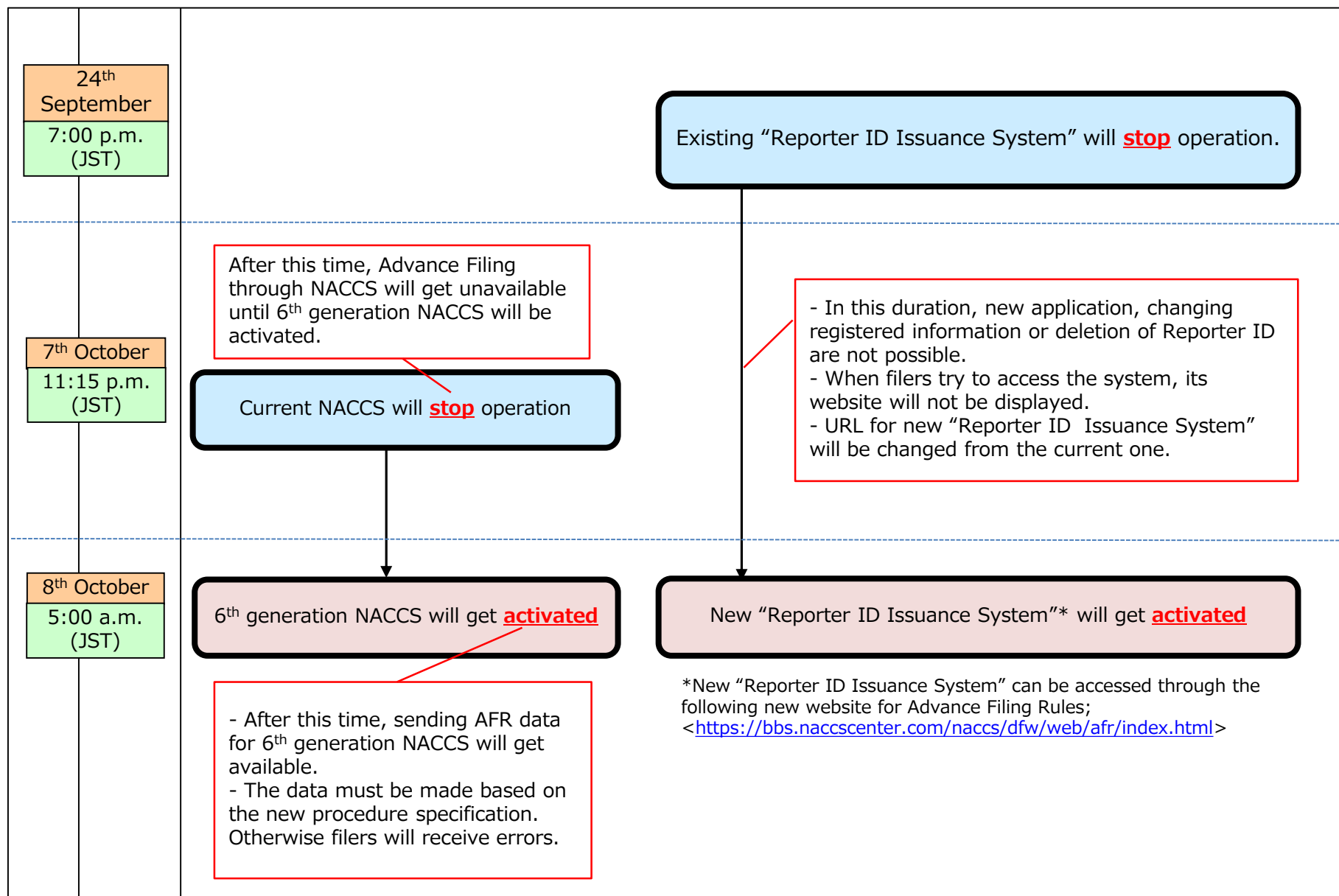


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1) Schedule for activation of 6th generation NACCS



Please inform filers of the following points!!

① **“Date and time for stopping connection with 5th generation NACCS”** and
“Date and time for activating connection with 6th generation NACCS”

Please clarify the following points for your customers.

- (i) Date and time when SP will stop sending/receiving data to/from 5th generation NACCS.
- (ii) Date and time when SP will start sending/receiving data to/from 6th generation NACCS.

With the above information, filers can see the duration when they can not use SP system for Advance Filing.

② **Deadline for Advance Filing**

In the event that the deadline for Advance Filing will come in the above duration when SP system is not available, filers must make filing beforehand.

Please inform filers of the following points!!

③ Reporter ID Issuance System

1. Existing Reporter ID Issuance System

- For ID data migration, Existing Reporter ID Issuance System will stop operation on “Sunday, 24 September 2017, 7:00 p.m. (JST)”.

2. New Reporter ID Issuance System*

- New Reporter ID Issuance System will get activated on “Sunday, 8 October 2017, 5:00 a.m. (JST)”, in accordance with the activation of 6th generation NACCS.

3. Reporter ID Issuance System unavailable duration

- Accordingly, in the following duration, “New application, Changing registered information or Deletion of Reporter ID” are not possible.

From; “Sunday, 24 September 2017, 7:00 p.m. (JST)”

To; “Sunday, 8 October 2017, 5:00 a.m. (JST)”.

4. Validity duration for Reporter IDs

- Validity duration for Reporter IDs, which are not expired as at “Sunday, 24 September 2017, 7:00 p.m. (JST)”, will be uniformly prolonged 1 year.

Please inform filers of the following points!!

④ Input condition for telephone number will get mandatory

From 6th generation NACCS, input of telephone numbers will get mandatory.

- Relevant AFR procedures; AMR, CMR, AHR and CHR
- Relevant Input Field; Consignor/Consignee/Notify Party Telephone Number

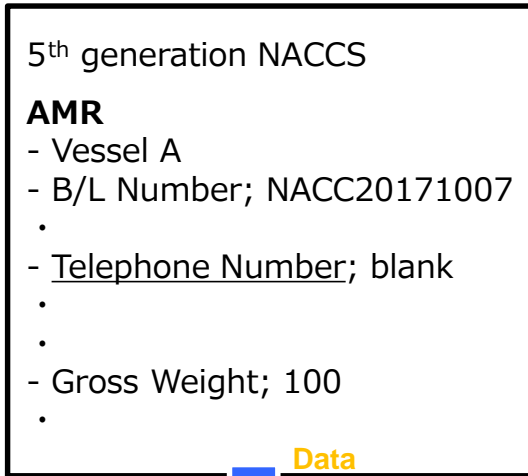
(Note) In accordance with this, please keep in mind the following points.

- (1) All filing data registered in current NACCS will be migrated to 6th generation NACCS.
- (2) Even though Consignor/Consignee/Notify Party Telephone Number fields in migrated data are blank, filers will not receive error.
- (3) However, when filers tried to do CMR (or CHR) for correcting information of migrated data (other than telephone numbers), they will receive an error* requesting the input of telephone numbers.

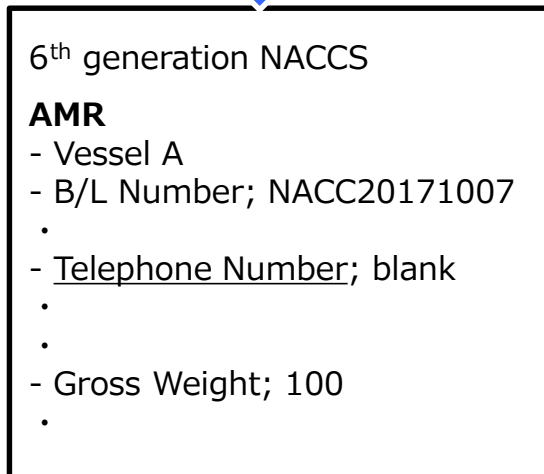

<AFR data migration image>

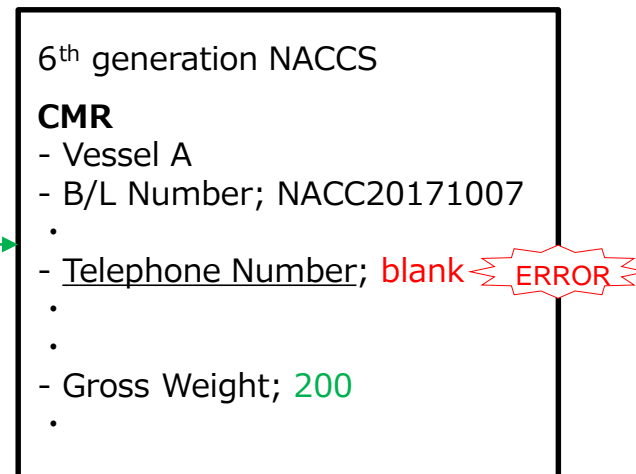
Filing data which has been registered in 5th generation NACCS will be copied to 6th generation NACCS.

Please inform filers of the following points!!

⑤ Other main points of modification in AFR procedures

1. New Input Field

(1) AHR/CHR . . . Vessel Information Change Identifier

When this field is filled with "Y", NACCS will automatically refer to the vessel information of relevant Master B/L without updating vessel information for House B/L. As a result, House B/L will possess 2 kinds of vessel information at the same time, hence Discrepancy in Vessel Information can be avoided.

(2) CMR/CHR . . . Reason for Deletion (Code)

2. New Output Information for matching status between Master B/L and House B/L

(1) SAS144 (Prior Notification Status of Relevant House B/L)

Filer of Master B/L can see that Prior Notification has been registered to relevant House B/L.

(2) SAS148 (Notification of Master B/L Registration Status)

Filer of House B/L can see if relevant Master B/L has been filed or not.

(3) SAS157 (Notification of House B/L Registration Status)

Filer of Master B/L can see that at least 1 relevant House B/L has been filed.

3. New AFR procedures

(1) BLL (Association of Registered B/L Numbers)

When there occurred Separate/Combine/Switch of B/L Numbers, filers can register relationship among these B/L Numbers by BLL procedure*. With this registration, Japan Customs can understand relationship among plural B/L Numbers registered in NACCS.

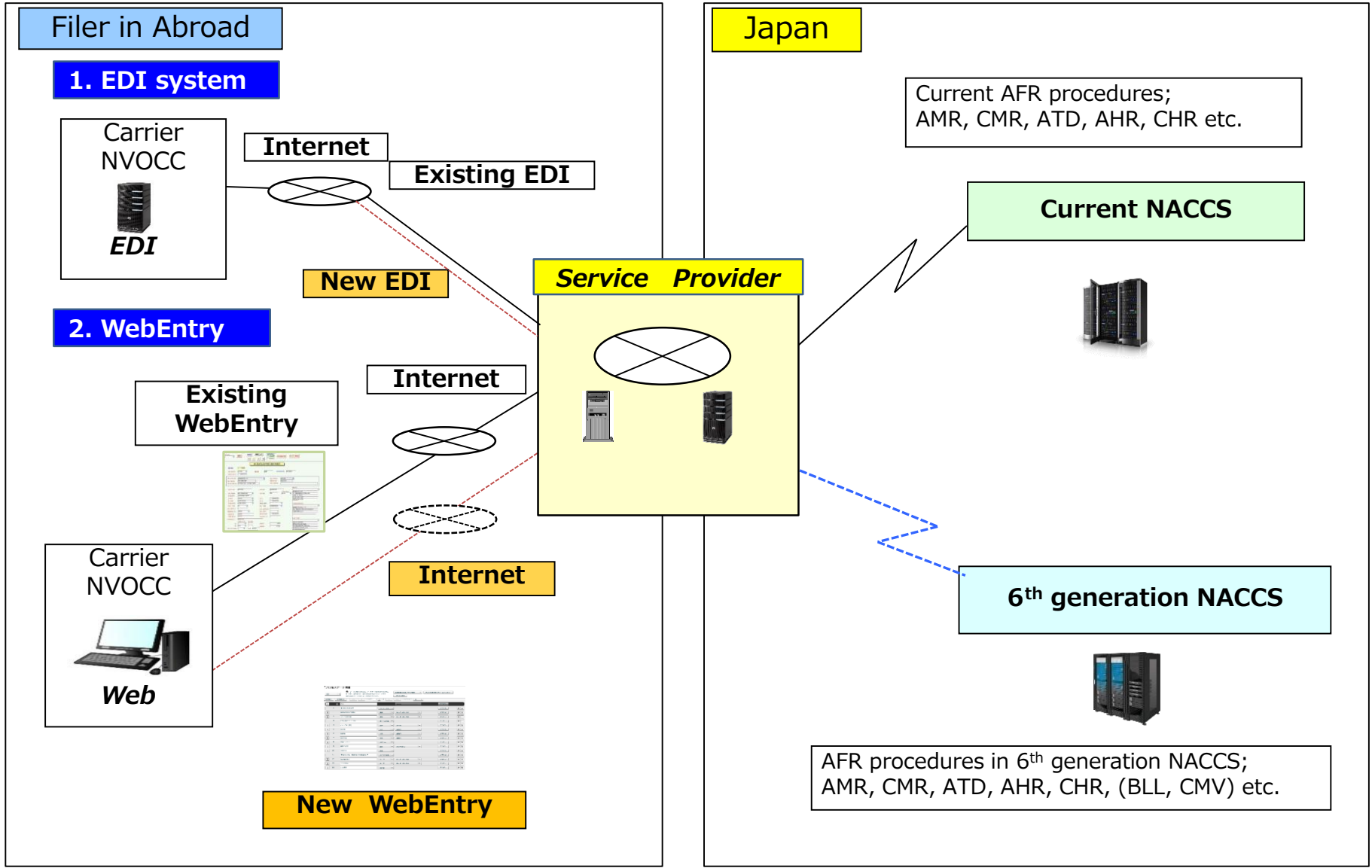
*All B/L Numbers have to be registered to NACCS before doing BLL.

(2) CMV (Update Registered Vessel Information for Advance Filing)

With CMV procedure, filers can correct Vessel Information of B/Ls in a lump in the unit of Carrier and Port of Loading. CMV procedure is regarded as "re-filing", hence implementation time of CMV will be filing time.

When the implementer of CMV is NVOCC, House END has to be done again.
