8.2 Connection Test Items to Prepare for Joining NACCS

Prior to conducting a connection test, each user is required to have certain items in place in addition to their company's own server. Table 8-2-1 shows the items that users need to prepare.

[11] Application for a connection test	Prior to conducting a connection test, users are required to apply for a connection test. NACCS Center will arrange the date of a test upon receipt of the application. The details regarding a connection test will be provided by NACCS Center to the applicant after the date of a connection test is arranged.
