

Table A6-8 Output Information Code List

Output information code

For all output information codes output in re-output procedure, 2 digits from the top become "R."

Output format for output information

- indicates a code is a output information code which is output in the Message Destination Control Format of the subject.
- indicates a output information code which is output in the Message Destination Control Format of the subject, and expresses that, even the message is EXC type, input information ID specified in the processing request message is output as is.

Procedure code

Indicates procedure code where the relevant output information code is output.

Message Type

- P indicates an Output Message (for printer).
- C indicates an Output Message (non-inquiry result) (for screen).
- M indicates an Output Message (inquiry result) (for screen).
- T indicates an Output Message (messages for user's own interface).
- U indicates an In-Storage Delivery Message (in-storage message).

Two-byte characters

Indicates output information codes where two-byte characters may be output.

Sequential Processing

- Pattern1 indicates subject to sequential processing in inquiry procedure.
- Pattern2 indicates subject to sequential processing in registration procedure.

Output Mode for sequential processing refer to "3.5 Message Control Items".
